Let's hope that the decent riding weather continues for a bit longer as it was glorious for the Flocking to Flowerdale run, but more on that in the club ride article.

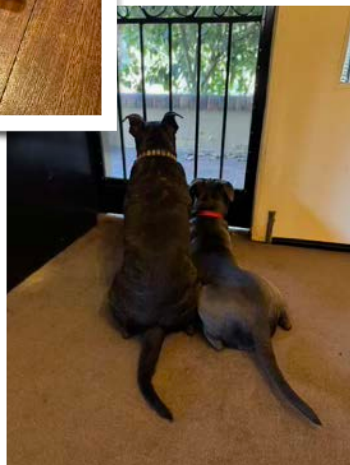
March always feels a bit discombobulating as the weather can swing between stifling hot and torrential rain so while the sun shines ride those roads!

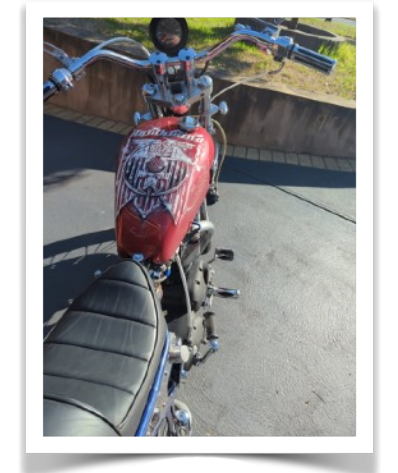

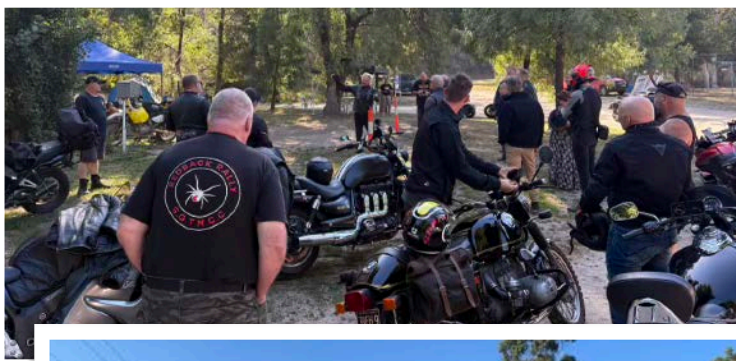


Nulli-Secundus Rally 2025

Longest distance male Lionel (NZ) 9 1/2 hours female Jackie Abrehart 352km

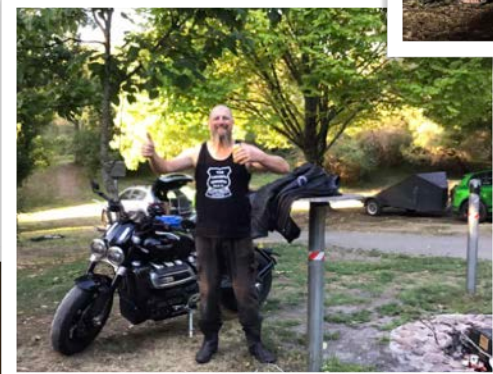
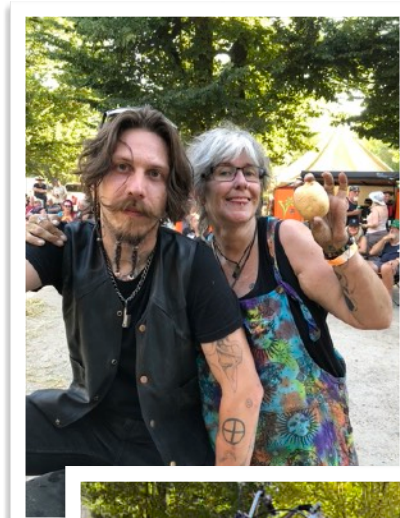
